## **NOTES FOR EXHIBITORS**

All goat classes are held under the Rules Regulations recognition of the British Goat Society. All exhibits must be registered with the British Goat Society as in the name and ownership of the exhibitor; the registered name, number and earmark being quoted on the entry form, along with kidding dates of goats in milk. All goats in milk must have kidded or aborted at least 30 days prior to the date of the show (18<sup>th</sup> August 2021). Attached Declaration form must be completed and returned with entries. Kids must be a minimum of 2 months old on day of show. The registration number of any goat initially entered must be submitted to the show secretary before the goat competes. No pregnant goat may enter the showground. In the event of an unforeseen kidding or abortion taking place, the goat must immediately be isolated from other goats. Full details of goat exhibitor and action taken must be reported in writing by the Chief Steward to the B.G.S Secretary immediately after the show.

### **C.A.E.**

All goats must have a valid C.A.E test certificate and must have tested negative within the last 12 months prior to the show. The certificate must show the earmark of the goat. Please note kids must have proof of being from a negative tested dam. Exhibitors are asked not to bring to the show any goat that has EVER had a positive reaction to a C.A.E test. Monitored herds will be penned separately. **A copy of the current C.A.E whole herd certificate must accompany your entry.**

**Arrival will be through Gate E.**

**All goats in milk must be on the showground by 5.30pm on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> September 2021 and must be stripped out by the appointed stewards by 6.30pm.**

**Udder inspection will be 7am on 18<sup>th</sup> September 2021, immediately followed by milking.**

**Kid and Goatling classes will be judged on Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> September 2021.**

**All goats entered must be penned.**

Earmarks will be checked.

Exhibitors are asked to use the milking area provided. The pail containing the milk of each exhibit must rest level with the ground and be capable of being carried single handed by a secure handle. The Chief Steward has the right to refuse to allow the use of any container that does not comply.

The Show Committee had the right to divide or cancel any class, its decision in this or any other matter is final.

## **Covid 19**

The Show will adhere to and have in place any Government safety and/ or preventative measures when the Show is taking place. These may include: -

- Social distancing.
- Advisory safety signage.
- The provision of hand sanitising stations.
- Provision of face masks.
- Controlled and limited access to enclosed areas.
- One-way routes around the Showground.

If you are feeling unwell before you leave for the show, please stay at home and do not attend. If you feel unwell whilst you are at the Show, stop showing immediately and notify the Show Secretary. All exhibitors will be expected to follow the requirements set out by Norwich and District Goat Club on arrival at the showground. Failure to follow these requirements may result in exhibitors being asked to leave the showground.

If the show has to be cancelled prior to its commencement, for reasons outside our control, all competitive entries will be refunded for the full amount paid.
